

Costa Mesa Regional Sewer Projects

Sewer Rehabilitation Along the 405



The regional sewer pipeline was installed in the 1960's. This project will repair cracks in the pipe to extend its useful life for another 25-30 years.

As the regional wastewater service provider, the Orange County Sanitation District (OC San) is committed to monitoring and evaluating its infrastructure regularly to ensure top performance and optimal levels of service and operations.

There are two OC San sewer projects in the City of Costa Mesa, including the **Sewer Rehabilitation along the 405**, as shown in the map in yellow.

This project includes the rehabilitation of approximately four miles of the regional sewer pipeline that runs along Interstate 405 in the City of Costa Mesa.

The project also includes manhole access improvements and rehabilitation of sewer pipelines crossing underneath the freeway.

Project Schedule

Summer 2024 - Early 2026

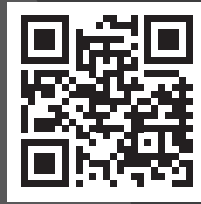
When construction begins on the project, it will be done in phases so as not to affect the entire project alignment at once.
