

# Airway Airport Loop Sewer Rehab



## Project Information

The Airway Airport Loop Sewer Rehabilitation project will rehabilitate two parallel regional sewer pipelines along a 1-mile stretch on Airway Avenue and Airport Loop Drive in the City of Costa Mesa, near the John Wayne Airport. The rehabilitation of the two pipelines must occur one at a time and will take place in separate phases to ensure continuous and uninterrupted sewer service. The project also includes improvements at the Main Street Pump Station in the City of Irvine to replace valves, piping, and vaults.

## Project Need

OC San is committed to protecting public health and the environment by proactively replacing and maintaining its infrastructure. The regional sewer pipelines and pump station valves have heavy corrosion and will be rehabilitated to extend its useful life for another 25-30 years and to continue providing reliable sewer service.
