OC San's Credit Rating Saves Taxpayers Millions

Fountain Valley, California – For 15 consecutive years, the Orange County Sanitation District (OC San) has maintained a AAA credit rating from three major credit rating firms: Fitch Ratings, S&P Global Ratings, and Moody's Investors Service, Inc.

The AAA rating, the highest possible, reflects OC San's strong management practices, prudent financial planning, and long-term fiscal stability. This distinction allows OC San to secure low-interest rates when refinancing bonds, resulting in substantial cost savings for ratepayers.

Currently, OC San has refinanced its 2016A obligations, generating an estimated \$16.8 million in savings for OC San and its ratepayers over the life of the bonds—an achievement made possible by OC San's consistent top-tier credit standing.

"OC San takes great pride in managing public funds responsibly and transparently," said Wally Ritchie, Director of Finance. "Maintaining our AAA rating year after year is a testament to our Board's leadership and staff's commitment to fiscal discipline. Through effective financial management and strategic refinancing, we're able to save our customers millions while continuing to invest in a reliable, sustainable wastewater system for generations to come."

OC San's strong credit ratings reflect its continued commitment to responsible financial stewardship and comprehensive long-term planning. OC San remains the only utility in California to receive the AAA rating from all three major credit rating agencies.

About OC San

OC San is a public agency that provides wastewater collection, treatment, and recycling for approximately 2.6 million people in central and northwest Orange County. OC San is a special district that is governed by a 25-member Board of Directors composed of 20 cities, four special districts, and one representative from the Orange County Board of Supervisors.
